ACCEPTABLE ULLAGE (FILL)

Bordeaux Levels:

Base Neck (BN) or higher – acceptable for all wines Top Shoulder (TS) – acceptable for wines 20 years or older High/Upper Shoulder (US) or Upper Mid Shoulder (UMS) – may be acceptable for wines 20 years old or older (if approved)

Burgundy Levels:

Up to 3 cm – acceptable for all wines 3-5 cm - ullage is acceptable for wines 20 years or older (with 5 cm being acceptable if approved)

LABEL CONDITION

Mint: The label is in perfect, pristine condition, with no marks, stains, or tears.

Bin: The label might be a bit dusty, perhaps from being stored in a cellar, but not stained.

Soiled: The label has visible stains or marks.

Torn: The label has been ripped or damaged.

*Important Note on Tax Receipts

(Wines Purchased Within the Past 3 Years OR Acquired Within the Past 10 Years with Intent to Donate)

If the wine was purchased within the past 3 years, or acquired within the past 10 years with the intention to donate, the tax receipt will reflect the **lesser** of the appraised value or the original purchase price.

In accordance with the **Income Tax Act**, the approximate **date of purchase/acquisition** and the **original purchase price** must be disclosed.
